Phonics Shed

Big Cat Phonics for Letters & Sounds Reading Scheme

This document maps the progression of Big Cat Phonics Fiction and Non-fiction books to the order of the Phonics Shed scheme. As with the Phonics Shed decodable reading scheme, the books should become decodable once the teaching for the Set it is assigned to is complete. Please note, some sets do not have books assigned to them and, as this is a scheme developed by an independent company, we cannot guarantee full decodability of every text.

If you are using these books to supplement the Phonics Shed decodable reading scheme, you will need to introduce additional HFWs to the standard Phonics Shed scheme. We have included the additional printable word cards at the end of this document (p.21 onwards).

Most of these HFWs are partially decodable CEWs; however, some are decodable when using the Phonics Shed scheme. Non-decodable GPCs will be shown in **bold**. The additional words are shown in **red** in the following table (from p.5). Most of the words are also covered at different points in the Phonics Shed scheme; the list on the following page notes where they are usually included or when they become decodable.

On the following pages (p.2-4) you will find a list of where we recommend including these additional HFWs. This is also noted in the bottom right-hand corner of the additional word cards at the end of this document (p.21 onwards).
