


#### What is a brown bear?

Brown bears live in mountain forests. They are large mammals. Brown bears from America are called 'Grizzly' bears. A brown bear has four legs and deadly, sharp claws. Brown bears are omnivores and eat fish, nuts, fruit and insects. Brown bears hibernate in the winter.


#### What is a skunk?

The skunk is a small mammal from North and South America with black and white fur. It is an omnivore and eats fruit and snakes. It sprays a smelly liquid when it is scared. Skunks are nocturnal and only come out at night and they live in woodlands.



#### What is a raccoon?

Raccoons are small mammals that live in woodlands. Raccoons are nocturnal omnivores and they eat things like frogs, mice and fruit. Some raccoons live near cities and eat rubbish out of bins! They are 40 to 70 cm in length. This is like the size of a cat.



#### What is a beaver?

The beaver is a small mammal that lives around ponds, lakes and rivers. They are herbivores and eat tree bark, plants and roots. They have big teeth and webbed feet. Beavers are nocturnal.
